**SPEAKER:** **Edward Towne** taught history at secondary schools in Bristol and Rochester, after gaining a BA in European Studies at UEA and a Cambridge PGCE and before completing a part-time MA in Early Modern English History at Birkbeck College, University of London. Later he took an MSt in Twentieth Century British History at Oxford University in 2001 (Beit Prize Winner), and taught in various schools until 2011. Since then he has lectured to adult groups and has also guided 7 trips to France and Belgium for the Historical Association.

Edward's talk on "**The Cambridge Spies**" will introduce the five prominent spies with their family and educational backgrounds, before describing the political and economic situation in Britain during the 1930's to try and account for the popularity of Marxist theory and Soviet practice at the time. He then looks at their careers in the British Establishment and for the USSR, as the "magnificent five" (in the words of their KGB controller). They were, however, exposed one by one, thus begging the questions: how did they continue to spy for so long, why did others from a similar background not spy, why were they not brought to trial, what damage did they do and what lessons have been learnt from this whole sorry saga?
